NOTICE OF HEARING

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1. The Court gives notice that it intends to hear oral argument in this proceeding on a single day on September 1, 2026. The Court expects to reserve approximately seven hours for the hearing, including appropriate recesses.
2. The precise hearing start time, applicable time zone, allocation of argument time, and other scheduling arrangements will be provided through CAAM.

VIRTUAL HEARING

3. The hearing will be conducted virtually through the Court's official Virtual Courtroom in accordance with Rules 20, 21, and 49–57 of the Rules of Procedure.
4. Unless the Court directs otherwise, the hearing will be public and recorded.

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

5. Internet Connection: Counsel and all other participants must have a reliable internet connection.
6. Suitable Device, Electronic Materials and Access: Participants must have a computer or other suitable device equipped with a functioning camera and microphone. Participants must have equipment that permits clear audio communication. Participants must have access to CAAM and the official electronic hearing bundle. Participants must have the software and credentials necessary to enter the Virtual Courtroom.

ADVANCE TESTING AND BACKUP ACCESS

7. Participants should test their equipment, internet connection, and access credentials sufficiently in advance of the hearing.
8. They should also arrange, where reasonably practicable, backup access through another device or internet connection.
9. A participant who anticipates a technological or accessibility difficulty must notify the Court through CAAM as soon as practicable.

ACCESS INFORMATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE QUESTIONS

10. Virtual Courtroom access information and any technical-testing arrangements will be provided through CAAM before the hearing.
11. Questions concerning access or other administrative arrangements must be submitted through CAAM. Such communications must not address the merits of the proceeding.
